Under AR 27-20, para. 10-3, the incident that forms the basis for the claim must arise in a foreign country and be a result of either noncombat activities of the U.S, armed forces or the negligent or wrongful acts of civilian employees or military members. "Noncombat activity" is defined in the Glossary of AR 27-20, as "authorized activities essentially military in nature, having little parallel in civilian pursuits, which historically have been considered as furnishing the proper basis for payment of claims. Activities excluded are those incident to combat, whether in time of war or not, and use of military personnel and civilian employees in connection with civil disturbances."
- b. Application of Rules. In this case, the claim arose in Afghanistan, a foreign country. The military vehicle driver engaged in negligent conduct by not proceeding in a safe manner, i.e., the driver's speed may have been excessive due to road conditions and did not ensure the right hand lane was clear prior to moving back into that lane.
