I have considered your claim under the Foreign Claims Act, Title 10 United States Code Section 2734 as implemented by Army Regulation 27-20, Chapter 10.

Your claim is denied. The Foreign Claims Act does not authorize payment of claims related to combat activities, nor of claims where US negligence cannot be established. Your claim states that your brother was shot at the gate of his house by Coalition Forces, killing him. The U.S. cannot pay your claim because your brother's death was incident to combat. I am sorry for your loss, and I wish you well in a Free Iraq.

Army Regulation 27-20 provides you the right to appeal this action. Deliver your appeal and any additional evidence to the Government Building FCC office within thirty (30) days of receipt of this notice.
