3. Amount of claim and filing date: Claimant filed a claim in the amount of \$10,000 on 11 Mar 06.
4. Chapter the claim was considered under and a brief description of the incident or of the issues raised by the claimant on reconsideration: Foreign Claims Act and Chapter 10, AR 27-20; claim filed for compensation for dead wife.
5. Facts: The claimant alleges that US Forces killed his wife.
6. Opinion: In order to form a basis for a claim under the FCA, the incident in question must have arisen outside the Unites States. In addition, the incident must be caused by either non-combat activities of the Unites States Armed Forces or by negligent or wrongful acts of military members or civilian employees of the Armed Forces. There is no evidence of US negligence or wrongful act.
7. Recommended Action: This claim is not payable under the FCA for the above mentioned reasons. Consequently, I recommend that this claim be denied.

6. Opinion: In order to form a basis for a claim under the FCA, the incident in question must have arisen outside the United States. In addition, the incident must be caused by either non-combat activities of the United States Armed Forces or by negligent or wrongful acts of military members or civilian employees of the Armed Forces. There is no photographs or autopsy reports. Evidence does not warrant US Forces negligence.
7. Recommended Action: This claim is not payable under the FCA for the above mentioned reasons. Consequently this claim for \$10,000 is denied.
