- 6. Opinion: In order to form a basis for a claim under the FCA, the incident in question must have arisen outside the Unites States. In addition, the incident must be caused by either non-combat activities of the Unites States Armed Forces or by negligent or wrongful acts of military members or civilian employees of the Armed Forces. There is no evidence of US negligence or wrongful act.
