ACTION

1. Facts: The claimant alleges that on 13 January 2005, two men were followed by US Forces who shot and killed them. Bullets struck her house and damaged the rooms. The amount requested in damages is \$3,000.
2. Opinion: The FCA permits compensation for damages caused by the negligent and wrongful acts of US forces. The claimant provided no evidence that the US committed a negligent or wrongful act. The incident was determined to be a combat action.
3. Authority: The Foreign Claims Act (10 U.S.C. § 2734) as implemented by AR 27-20, Chapter 10.
4. Action: The claim is therefore denied.
