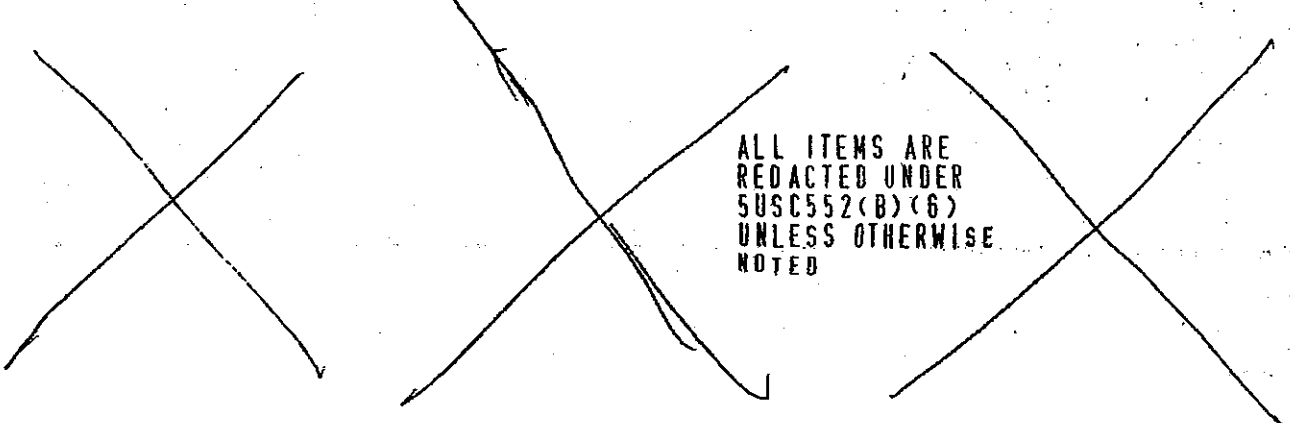

I received word that my son was to move out to a spot just north of the Grain
station via [REDACTED], and pull up security where 3rd Platoon took control. Upon
our arrival we discovered a Red & Black car with 2 adult males in the front. Both men
were KIA, there were about 15 IP's on site when we arrived, with no US presence.
We searched the car, found nothing in the trunk, front-back seat, in the glove box.
We did a search of the surrounding area, approx 100m all around the car for weapons or
brass, we found one piece of 5.56 brass about 25m south of the car. The car
itself was shot up pretty good, there were about 10-15 hits from various angles. There
was also a good amount of damage to the left side of the car from what looked
like an accident due to the broken tail light on the ground behind the car.
After talking to the IP's on site they informed us that there were two women
in the back of the car, both were still breathing when they got there so they escorted
them to the hospital. We called for guidance on the radios + the air, they
informed us to let the IP's handle care of the. We supplied the body bags + were
cleared to leave. Nothing follows

PATROL ON FOLLOWED A VEHICLE THAT WAS OUT PAST CUREFEM. A CORDON WAS SET AROUND THE VEHICLE WITH 1X M1114 IN FRONT OF THE VEHICLE AND 3X M1114 BEHIND THE VEHICLE. UPDATE: 0930 THE UNIT STOPPED THE VEHICLE. TWO LEADERS ATTEMPTED TO OPEN THE DOORS AND GET THE OCCUPANTS OUT OF THE VEHICLE. THE VEHICLE THEN BEGAN TO DRIVE FORWARD AT THE LEADERS, SO A WARNING SHOT WAS FIRED INTO THE AIR. THE VEHICLE THEN CONTINUED AND A SHOT WAS FIRED INTO THE GRILL. 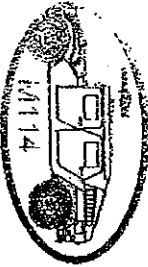

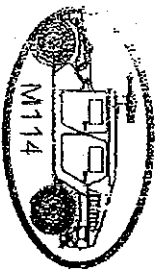

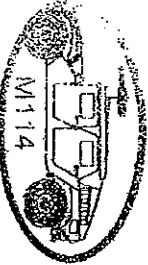

SUMMARY OF INCIDENT: While on patrol of zone 25, Patrol 619 spotted a vehicle out during curfew hours. The patrol chased down the vehicle and blocked it off near CP 544 [REDACTED] and the TC [REDACTED] (SSG [REDACTED] and a dismount (SGT [REDACTED]) from the lead M1114 dismounted to speak with the occupants. The vehicle did not fully stop and began moving forward towards SGT [REDACTED], then moved back again, and proceeded to move forward again. Both SSG [REDACTED] and SGT [REDACTED] attempted to stop the vehicle with hand/arm signals, then by shouting at the occupants while showing their weapons. Then went up to the vehicle and tried to get the occupants to open the door. SGT [REDACTED] fired a warning shot into the air. The vehicle then proceeded to back straight up into the 2<sup>nd</sup> M1114 (which was parked approximately 25 meters behind it), with 1LT [REDACTED] standing in front of that M1114. Based on the way the occupants in the vehicle were acting towards the patrol, the majority of the personnel in the patrol feared that the vehicle was a possible VBIED and was attempting to ram the second M1114 in [REDACTED]

order to detonate and kill/harm US forces. 1LT [REDACTED] dove out of the way of the vehicle as it came back towards him and hit the 2<sup>nd</sup> M1114. The vehicle was engaged from the front by SSG [REDACTED] who fired disabling shots into the grill and tires with his M4 and PFC [REDACTED] who fired a controlled burst with his M4 at the vehicle tires. The vehicle was engaged from the rear from the second M1114 when it was ramming into them by the gunner who fired two burst of 50 Cal of approximately 10 rounds total, and then finally SGT [REDACTED] who came from the third M1114 to assist fired into the car with his M4. Once the vehicle had been fired upon, it was determined that there were 2 LN female wounded and 2 LN male KIA. Two US personnel were wounded from the front M1114 and they were SSG [REDACTED] and SGT [REDACTED]. As the patrol was rendering first aid the Iraqi ISF POB showed up at the scene and the patrol told them that they had to evacuate casualties and that the POB soldiers were to deal with the situation while the patrol drove to the CASH with US casualties. A different patrol from A Co was actioned to the scene and arrived within 30 minutes. By the time the second patrol arrived the Iraqi Police were on the scene also. The vehicle was searched and no explosives or weapons were found. IP's had taken control of the KIA and WIA LN's. The civilian vehicle involved in the engagement is being taken care of by the IP's and 21<sup>st</sup> MP's.

It continued and further shots were fired at the vehicle including approximately 10 shots from the second M1114s 50 Cal.

3. Using miniature HMMWVs and soldiers, each the soldiers of the patrol talked through each event, in time and space, addressing their thoughts and actions.

  - g. Moving in front of the sedan and stopping to set up the rolling TCP

  - i. The driver of the vehicle moves forward and the actions of the Soldiers
  - j. The warning shot fired by SGT [REDACTED] and SSG [REDACTED] or kicking the front of the sedan
