1. You are hereby appointed Investigating Officer pursuant to AR 15-6 to conduct an informal investigation into the shooting of a local national vehicle that resulted in 1 KIA. This occurred in the vicinity of [REDACTED] on or about 241145JUN05. You should rely on your military knowledge and experience when ascertaining the facts relative to the investigation and in the framing of your recommendations.
2. In your investigation, all witness statements will be sworn and provided on DA Form 2823, Sworn Statement.
3. All interviewees suspected of possible Uniform Code of Military Justice violations will execute DA Form 3881, Rights Warning Procedure/Waiver Certificate.
4. Submit your findings and recommendations on DA Form 1574 to this headquarters within 72 hours. Your findings should include a comprehensive and chronological description of events as well as your understanding of why the incident occurred. Recommendations should include but not be limited to corrective actions designed to prevent future occurrences of the same or similar incidents. In the event your recommendations include disciplinary action, do not recommend specific levels of disposition or punishments.
5. At the conclusion of your investigation, you will submit your DA Form 1574 and all exhibits to the Staff Judge Advocate for legal review.

## SECTION IV - FINDINGS (para 3-10, AR 13-6)

The investigating officer (board), having carefully considered the evidence, finds:

As the appointed investigating officer for AR 13-6, No. 05-239, I have completed my investigation of the aforementioned matter and submit my report in the following format: FACTS, FINDINGS and RECOMMENDATIONS.

**FACTS:** On 24 JUNE 2005, at approximately 1136 hours, members of [REDACTED] and members of [REDACTED] were conducting a joint security patrol in the [REDACTED] area vicinity of grid [REDACTED]. While the patrol was in route to conduct Mosque monitoring operations, a shot was heard and a local national was spotted on a roof top at the aforementioned grid coordinate, which is located on the south east intersection of Routes [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. (EXHIBITS 1, C5, C8) The patrol leader, [REDACTED] immediately halted the patrol, set the patrol members into hasty overwatch positions and the patrol began clearing the building in which the local national was observed. (EXHIBIT C8) The patrol had received direct fire in the same area on 23 JUNE 2005. (EXHIBIT C3). While members of the joint patrol cleared the building, the remaining members provided an outer cordon. The platoon's [REDACTED] and his spotter, [REDACTED], occupied a position just to the north of the building that was being searched. Other members of the patrol [REDACTED] occupied positions along the outer perimeter of the building. Several [REDACTED] soldiers occupied positions along the south side of [REDACTED] or Route [REDACTED]. (EXHIBIT A1). Both CP and IA soldiers were stopping all west bound traffic on Route [REDACTED] approximately 100 meters east of the outer cordon that the joint patrol had set. One vehicle had stopped in the middle of Route [REDACTED] approximately 100 meters east of the outer cordon. (EXHIBIT C, C1, C2, C4). A Daewoo Espiro, white in color, bearing a Baghdad license plate [REDACTED], driven by [REDACTED], traveled around the stopped car 100 meters to the east of the established outer cordon headed in a westerly direction towards the joint patrol. As the vehicle approached the outer cordon personnel, at a high rate of speed, audible and visual signals were given by members of the patrol for the vehicle to stop. As it by-passed the stopped vehicle parked in the road a warning shot was fired by [REDACTED]. The vehicle continued to approach the outer cordon and ignore verbal and visual commands to stop. As the vehicle approached without slowing, [REDACTED] fired a disabling shot to the right front tire, while [REDACTED] fired into the grill of the vehicle. These shots were fired when the vehicle was approximately 70 meters from the outer cordon. The vehicle's rate of speed towards the joint patrol's outer cordon did not change and it continued to ignore all displayed commands to stop. (EXHIBITS B2, B3, B4, B5, C, C1, C2, C4) When the vehicle reached approximately 40 meters from the position occupied by [REDACTED] he fired his weapon, with a point of aim being the driver's head. The vehicle began to slow down. When the vehicle reached a distance of approximately 20 meters from the intersection of Routes [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] an IA soldier ran out into the street and fired point blank into the vehicle. The vehicle traveled only a few more meters and came to a halt. Joint patrol soldiers searched the vehicle and found the driver to be dead. Only personal effects of its driver were found in the vehicle. (EXHIBIT C3, C4). After the inspection of the vehicle and the incident reported the joint patrol force left the area to continue with its mission. (EXHIBIT C9)

**FINDINGS:** After careful review of all available evidence and interviews with all available witnesses, I report the following findings. The patrol was very familiar with the area of operations. The patrol had been fired upon numerous times in the vicinity of the incident. The patrol had tried on all occasions prior to gain PID of the sniper but to no avail. As the patrol was fired upon on 24 JUNE 05, all actions of the patrol had to be carried out in a most expedient manner. Speed being essential in an attempt to apprehend or kill the AIF sniper. It was also essential in an effort to provide force protection of the patrol that they move into and occupy outer cordon security position hastily, as the location of the sniper was unknown. HMMV's were used to block the southern, northern and western high speed avenues of approach. Dismounts were utilized to block all traffic from the eastern direction. This attempt to gain PID of the sniper did not afford the ability to place barrier materials in the eastern flank of the objective due to the requirement for speed of action. It is evident that the units methods to divert or stop traffic were effective, in that all vehicles except that driven by [REDACTED] obeyed all commands not to enter into the outer cordon or pass the stopped car that held it's position in the center of Route [REDACTED]

## SECTION V - RECOMMENDATIONS (para 3-11, AR 13-6)

In view of the above findings, the investigating officer (board) recommends:

**RECOMMENDATIONS:** Leaders must continue to stress to soldiers to utilize the graduated response threat matrix and to continue to train them in the proper use of the ROE. Leaders must also continue to stress the importance of maintaining full situational awareness, as complacency will take its toll on our soldiers should they become such. However leaders must ensure that though they must teach and enforce the standards of the graduated response matrix they do not by any means instill in their soldiers hesitation. Situational awareness will provide our soldiers the ability to make the right decision at a critical moment, whereas hesitation at a critical moment will surely cost life or limb, neither of which we can afford. It is recommended, however that the unit be trained in proper consequence management. The unit, at a minimum should have remained at the incident site until a complete battle hand over with the local authorities or another unit was accomplished. By leaving the deceased subject in plain view and leaving the area, the unit could not have had a positive impact on the local populace. I have no further recommendations.

I also find that all of the Rules of Engagement were followed in that the unit utilized the graduated response threat matrix in their attempts to stop the on coming vehicle. The unit first utilized visual and audible signs, to no avail, then fired warning shots which rendered no positive response. As the vehicle closed to within 40 meters the soldiers were left with only one option, the use of deadly force to deter the perceived threat. (EXHIBITS A-A16) I find that the fatal wound to the subject's head was delivered from the shot fired by [REDACTED]. I also find that the wounds to the subjects right hand were caused by the shot fired by the [REDACTED], which is clearly indicated by the implosion of glass into the vehicle. (EXHIBITS A15-A16) It is also evident by the wound on the subject hand. (EXHIBIT A16) The IA soldier who fired point blank into the vehicle was identified, but refused to admit that he in fact fired into the vehicle, though several eye witnesses observed his actions. (EXHIBITS C, C3, C4)

While pulling security, a vehicle was stopped 100M from soldiers. A second vehicle came at high rate of speed and did not respond to an IA soldier and swerved around first vehicle. [REDACTED] & [REDACTED] screamed and waved at car. Vehicle continued at high rate of speed. Warning shot fired into ground, second

shot blew out tire, next shot into engine block, last shot through the windshield. At the same time IA was shooting rounds through drivers side window. Car came to a stop at soldiers and LN was dead.



At around 1136 hrs myself and [REDACTED] were overwatching a building vicinity of [REDACTED] while soldiers from [REDACTED] and Iraqi Army soldiers searched the building. We were positioned on a side road to the east of route [REDACTED]. We had multiple vehicles approach our position and [REDACTED] and Iraqi soldiers would motion the vehicles to stop before they would be near our location. While we were in the process of signalling a vehicle that we stopped to turn around, we noticed a vehicle approaching at a high rate of speed approx. 40 mph. [REDACTED], myself, and the Iraqi soldier started yelling and waving for the vehicle to stop. The vehicle was approximately 150 meters from our location. The vehicle continued at a high rate of speed never slowing down. [REDACTED] then fired a warning shot at the vehicle. I then fired a shot at the road in front of the vehicle. The vehicle never slowed down. When the vehicle was approximately 70 meters I fired a round into the engine and [REDACTED] shot out the right front tire.
