



LINE 6: SUMMARY OF INCIDENT: A patrol from 3/A/3-7 IN was moving north on RTE when a white HONDA ACCENT approached the rear of the convoy at a high rate of speed. The gunner in the rear 1114 attempted to signal the car to maintain a safe distance using light/verbal signals. The driver did not move back. The gunner then pointed his weapon directly at the vehicle and continued to give verbal warnings. The vehicle moved closer to the rear of the convoy. The gunner then fired 1x 5.56MM warning shot. The vehicle sped up. The gunner then fired 1x 5.56MM disabling shot into the hood of the vehicle. The HONDA came to an abrupt halt. The patrol dismounted their vehicles to check the status of the driver and question him. Immediately after dismounting the vehicles, the HONDA started moving again, traveling north in the direction of the halted patrol. 7 members of the patrol then fired kill shots at the vehicle. Approximately 3x 7.62MM rounds, 1x 12 gauge round, and 30x 5.56MM rounds were fired into the vehicle. The HONDA continued to speed past the convoy until it struck a Bradley Fighting Vehicle. The vehicle continued and then hit an 1114 from the patrol. Members of the patrol were now taking cover as the vehicle sped off, traveling approximately 200m north before coming to a final halt. The patrol then moved to cordon off the car. Two other patrols helped to set in a cordon. The IPs arrived and searched the car. The IPs reported the car to be clear of weapons and explosives. The IPs also reported the LN driver was KIA. The LN was identified as The IPs then took control of the scene and the patrol continued its

mission. There were no US injuries.

The gunner on D1-1 (PFC flashed a spotlight several times at the vehicle with no effect, and began firing warning shots from his M16A2, and because of the vehicle's high rate of speed, immediately began firing into the hood and vehicle. The sedan continued to pass D1-1 on the left side, and then swerve to the right side of the road behind A1-7. At this time the gunner for A1-7 began engaging the vehicle with warning and disabling shots from his M240B where he fired 3-5 rounds before the vehicle was passing A1-7 on the right side. Because of the amount of cars in the early morning fuel line, he could not continue to engage the vehicle while it was along the right side of A1-7. The car sped towards the BFV, and then suddenly stopped. The BFV turned sideways to block the road, and A1-7 and D1-1 approached the vehicle from a safe distance. Both MIII4's shined spotlights on the vehicle, and the interpreter was on the loudspeaker telling the drive to stop, turn off his car, get out, etc. The crews from both M1114's dismounted and stayed a safe distance from the vehicle. The sedan then went into reverse, (the back up lights were on), and began moving backwards towards A1-7. The crew from A1-7 fired more disabling shots into the tires and engine in a final attempt to stop the vehicle before using deadly force. The sedan then turned to the left, and the driver opened the door and stepped out. The driver was not visibly wounded at this time. The crewmembers as well as the interpreter used loud, clear instructions in Arabic telling the driver to put up his hands and walk towards them. Still fearing that the vehicle was a failed VBIED, none of the soldiers approached the vehicle or driver. The driver put his hands up for a brief moment, and then quickly jumped back into the car and put it into drive. He mashed the accelerator, causing the tires to spin, and then accelerate quickly towards the BFV which was parked sideways. At this time nearly all infantry on the ground engaged the driver with deadly force. Just before the sedan impacted with the BFV, the driver slumped over to the right in the seat, and the sedan swerved left across the median, down a small embankment, through a fence and some shrubbery, and came to a stop just before hitting an apartment building. The patrol cordoned off the area, with the assistance of elements from Bravo and Delta companies, and prepared to send up a request for EOD. At this time. Two IP vehicles came from The IP's walked up to the vehicle, opened the trunk, and confirmed that it was not a VBIED. Once the patrol confirmed that it was not a VBIED SPC (medic) moved to the LN to administer aid and check vital signs. As the patrol was mounting up a LN approached them and said that a bullet had impacted his vehicle, but there were no casualties. It appeared that a bullet had ricochet from the hood of his car and through the passenger side window. His name was "the same was "the s

## Recommendations:

There is no indication of any negligence or carelessness on the part of the Soldiers on this patrol. They used proper force escalation procedures, as outlined in the published Rules of Engagement. The vehicle showed multiple patterns consistent with a VBIED attack. The Soldiers used the appropriate RAMP procedures, and subsequently the situation escalated to the point where deadly force was the only solution to protect themselves and the patrol against the perceived threat. The local national was given several chances to comply before deadly force was applied. It was an unfortunate, but un-avoidable situation. As soon as the Iraqi Police identify the LN's family, the Patrol leader should write a letter of condolence to the family, and make his best effort to visit them.

COMPANY COMMANDER'S SIGNATURE:

Comments: This situation is difficult to fully understand. The patrol used the proper escalation procedures when dealing with this perceived VBIED threat, although the vehicle did get too close if it were a VBIED. This is a challenge for patrols, weighing the risk of their security buffer and the consequences of taking the life of a confused, disoriented local national Iraqi citizen. I am proud that they conducted an assessment, and escalated the force appropriately as the situation unraveled. I am worried that if this vehicle were a VBIED, that it was able to get as close as it did. At such a high rate of speed, there is not a lot of time to adjust from flashlight to weapon in order to fire off warning, then disabling shots.

Recommend: One possible recommendation would be for vehicles to be installed with some form of blinking light, or a light similar found to those on police vehicles. The light would have to be wired so that its employment could be initiated at the command of the vehicle's gunner. Especially since the gunner of the rear vehicle has better situational awareness at the 6 o'clock position than anyone else in the patrol. I think this man was given several opportunities to avoid his untimely death, but was probably confused and scared. Having these "warning lights" that produce a signal that is easily identified because of its color, or repetition in flashing may prevent this event from occurring again. In the meantime, we will continue to use the spotlights that we have either been issued or purchased, and attempt to raise the attention of local national traffic by flashing. In this case, however, I don't know of any other warning that the patrol could have conducted in such a short time span to prevent the ultimate end.



Our speed was MPH, and the sedan was traveling approximately 60 MPH. Visibility was approximately 75%, as we had just passed BMNT. Our order of march was times at the vehicle with no effect, and began firing warning shots from his M16A2, and because of the vehicle's high rate of speed, immediately began firing into the hood and vehicle. The sedan continued to on<u>the</u> left side, and then swerve to the right side of the road behind t At this time the began engaging the vehicle with warning and disabling shots from his M240B where he gunner for fired 3-5 rounds before the vehicle was passing on the right side. Because of the amount of cars in the early morning fuel line, he could not continue to engage the vehicle while it was along the right side of The car sped towards the and then suddenly stopped. The turned sideways to block the road, and A1-7 and D1-1 approached the vehicle from a safe distance. Both M1114's shined spotlights on the vehicle, and the interpreter was on the loudspeaker telling the drive to stop, turn off his car, get out, etc. The crews from both M1114's dismounted and stayed a safe distance from the vehicle. The sedan then went into reverse, (the back up lights were on), and began moving backwards towards fired more disabling shots into the tires and engine in a final attempt to stop the vehicle before using deadly force. The sedan then turned to the left, and the driver opened the door and stepped out. The driver was not visibly wounded at this time. The crewmembers as well as the interpreter used loud, clear instructions in Arabic telling the driver to put up his hands and walk towards them. Still fearing that the vehicle was a failed VBIED, none of the soldiers approached the vehicle or driver. The driver put his hands up for a brief moment, and then quickly jumped back into the car and put it into drive. He mashed the accelerator, causing the tires to spin, and then accelerate quickly towards the which was parked sideways. At this time nearly all infantry on the ground engaged the driver with deadly force. Just before the sedan impacted with the the driver slumped over to the right in the seat, and the sedan swerved left across the median, down a small embankment, through a fence and some shrubbery, and came to a stop just before hitting an apartment building. We cordoned off the area, with the assistance of elements from Bravo and Delta companies, and prepared to send up a 9 line request for EOD. At this time. Two IP vehicles came from The IP's walked up to the vehicle, opened the trunk, and confirmed that it was not a VBIED. Once we confirmed that it was not a VBIED SPC (medic) moved to the LN to administer aid and check vital signs. He determined that there were no vital signs and that the LN was KJA due to multiple GSW to the upper torso and head. The IP officer that responded was ILT from the IP station, POC (office) / (mobile), and he said that he had already contacted for an ambulance and tow truck support. We identified the LN as "Mohamed Ali Hussien Alaywi", 66 YO, based on identification found in his vehicle. We were unable to determine his address, but ILT said that he would contact me as soon as he did, and also when his investigation was complete. I took photographs and notes, and the IP's said that they did not need any further assistance. We left the scene at 0640. As we were mounting up a LN approached us and said that a bullet had impacted his vehicle, but there were no casualties. It appeared that a bullet had ricochet from the hood of his car and through the passenger side window. His name was , and I took photographs, gave him my number, and explained the claims process to him. Battle roster numbers and round counts were:

He seemed very reluctant and not very motivated to have the elections at his clinic. Several times he gave us kind of a "why don't you just have them somewhere else" attitude. He also said that last year they were given no notice, and that a bunch of people just showed up that morning and set up in a room, and then decided not to have the elections there, and left. He also said that he had no idea that they were having them there this year, and that no one had notified him. Regardless, we talked with him and got his information. We left at 0945. At 1045 we went to the District Election office in to make contact with the headmaster and just to see how things were going with regards to the elections. The headmaster was not there, so we will have to go back another day.

At 1110 we went to the state of the land to just touch base with him. When we arrived, a 10 year old girl was the only person who answered the gate. She said that she was the only one home, and had no idea where her parents were or when they would be back. I think there may have been someone else there, but they did not want to talk to us. Regardless, we left.

At 1130 we went to the @ MB to see if the Imam was in, and engage him. His cousins said that the Imam was only in on Thursdays and Fridays, because he studies in during the week. They invited us in, however, and we talked for approximately 45 minutes. His cousin's names were They were very friendly men, and told me at this location. They said that before the invasion it was run by Saddam, and that now only about 15 people (close family) attend it. They said that they did not follow any specific Shia tract, but they were just simple Muslim men. They did say that they were very happy to see the barriers down at a k, because they thought that they would deter strange cars from driving through the area. They said that they would also welcome barriers blocking the small bridge across the canal into We talked about religion, politics, the Tribe, and football, and we left there at 1230.
