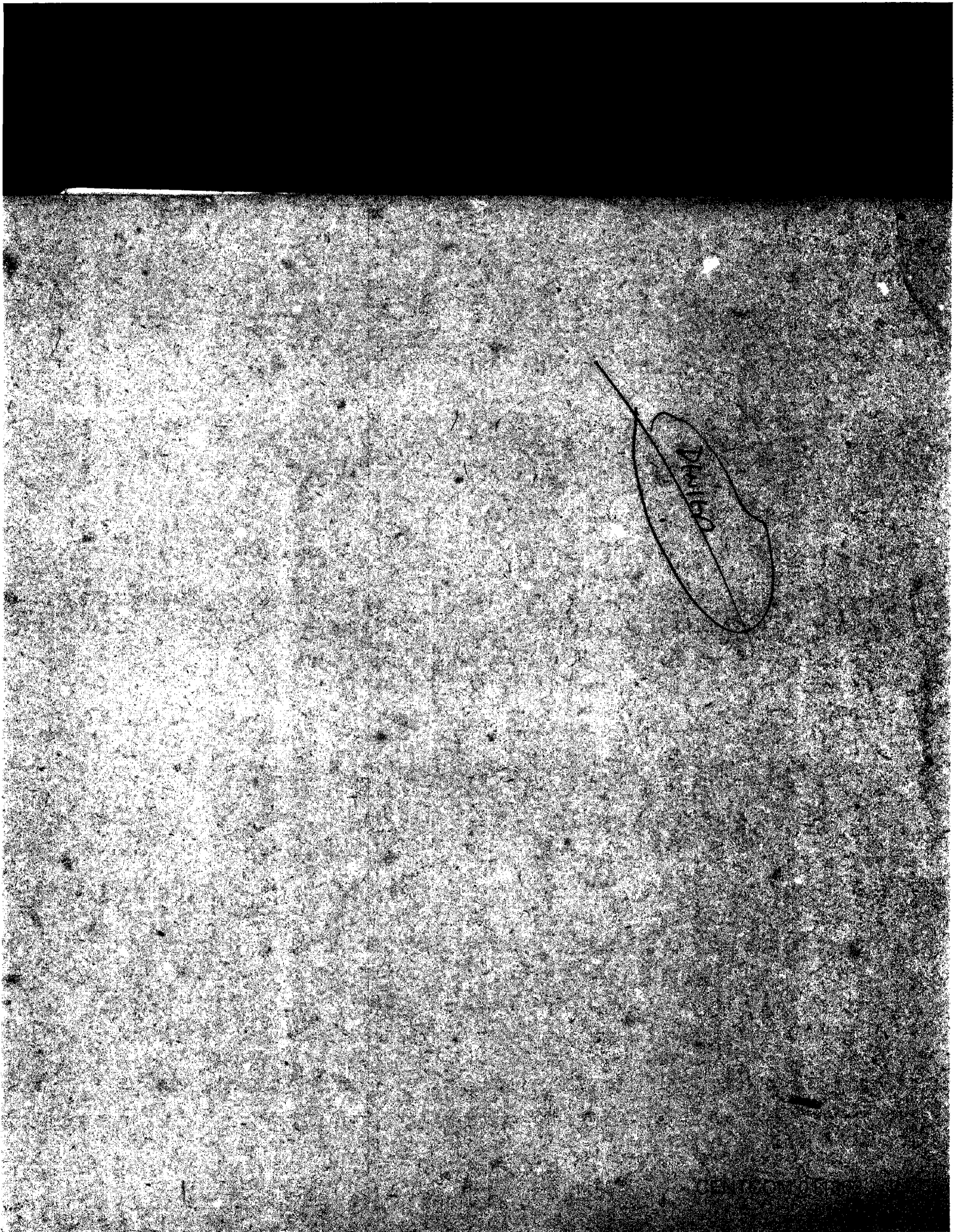

281130OCT06: NSW ISO 1/6 MAR engaged AIF while conducting security and overwatch operations IVO [redacted] (2)H in central Al Ramadi. The overwatch element established PID of (2) AIF moving tactically and carrying (1) RPG round IVO [redacted] (2)H between Buildings 140 and 141, approximately [redacted] (2)H southeast of their position. The element determined hostile intent and engaged the AIF with (2) rounds .300 Win Mag. with negative effects. 10 minutes later, the overwatch element established PID of the same (2) AIF moving tactically and observing their position. Snipers engaged each AIF with (1) round .300 Win Mag, resulting in [redacted] (2)H. At approximately 1150C, the NSW element observed (2) AIF moving tactically towards their position, carrying (1) AK-47 and observing their position with (1) set of binoculars. OW element determined hostile intent and engaged the AIF with (1) round of .300 Win Mag, resulting in [redacted] (2)H. There were no injuries or equipment damages to CF.

281145OCT06: NSW ISO 1/6 MAR engaged (1) AIF while conducting security and overwatch operations IVO (b)(2)High in central Ar Ramadi. The unit observed (1) AIF carrying (1) AK-47 and moving tactically toward their position from building 97 in sector H-1 (b)(2)High 250m to their east. The NSW sniper determined hostile intent and engaged the (1) AIF with (1) round (b)(2)High mm, resulting in There were no injuries or equipment damages to CF.

281235OCT06: A/1/6 MAR engaged (1) AIF while conducting security and observation operations IVO [redacted] (2) High in central Ar Ramadi. The unit observed (1) AIF using hand and arm signals IVO [redacted] (2) High. Simultaneously A/1/6 was attacked with (1) round IDF with a POI IVO [redacted] (2) High. A/1/6 MAR determined this to be a hostile act and engaged the mortar observer with (3) rounds 5.56mm (M16) resulting in [redacted] (2) High. The (1) AIF WIA was removed from the site by unknown individuals, who pulled the (1) AIF WIA behind a building [redacted] (2) High. [redacted] (2) High had (1) acquisition with a radar POO at [redacted] (2) High. Counter fire was not conducted due to CDE restrictions. Crater analysis will be conducted when tactically possible. There were no injuries or equipment damages to CF. [redacted] (2) High

(b)(2)High

181305OCT06: Mobile Assault Platoon 1/6 MAR was attacked with SAF while conducting security and observation operations IVO Firecracker intersection (b)(2)High in Central Ar Ramadi. The attack consisted of (30-40) rounds of 7.62mm (PKC) from approximately (b)(2)High to their east IVO (b)(2)High. The unit established PID of an unknown number of AIF on the 2nd floor of a building IVO (b)(2)High and an unknown number of AIF in a building IVO (b)(2)High. The unit returned fire at the muzzle flashes with (50) rounds .50cal and (100) rounds 7.62mm (M240). The attack ceased but the unit was unable to determine BDA. There were no injuries or equipment damages to CF.
