

 DESCRIPTION: The claimant reports that his brother was returning home from visiting relatives when he approached an US forces checkpoint. There were nine passengers in the vehicle, three were killed, four were seriously injured, and their vehicle was damaged. The family was compensated for the three deaths, but is requesting additional compensation for the serious injuries and vehicle that was damaged. JUSTIFICATION: By making this condolence payment, MNF ensures the family and community recognize the MNFs' sympathy for the unfortunate loss. Support will positively influence both the community and local Iraqi leaders.

guards then perceived the vehicle as hostile and engaged the vehicle with killing bursts into the cab with M240 and M249. After a cease fire, the guards observed the vehicle with optics to determine if the vehicle was a PVBIED. Initial observation of the vehicle was that it was riding low on its shocks, and had the appearance of a VBIED. Initial decision was to contact EOD; however, after further evaluation they observed children standing in the vehicle. Guards then approached the vehicle to further evaluate the situation. Upon further review the guards determined the vehicle was not a threat and immediately began treating the injured IZ's. There was a total of (9) passengers in the vehicle ((3) adult males - ages unknown, (1) adult female - age unknown, (4) female
