

INVESTIGATIVE UMMARY: THE INFORMATION IN THIS REPORT IS BASED UPON AN ALLEGATION OR PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATION AND MAY CHANGE PRIOR TO THE COMPLETION OF THE INVESTIGATION. THIS IS AN "OPERATION IRAOI FREEDOM" INVESTIGATION. On 2 Jun 04, this investigation was initiated based on a Memorandum of Transmittal 0171-04-CID919 from the 75th Military Police Detachment (CID) (FWD), LSA Anaconda, Balad, IZ, which related while detained at an unknown facility in Balad, IZ and had 30,300,000.00 Iraqi Dinar seized from him, of which only 8 million was returned to him upon his release. Investigation established there was insufficient evidence to substantiate cruelty and maltreatment and aggravated assault. Therefore, the allegations were unfounded. was stopped at a security checkpoint for transporting an excess of 25 million Iraqi Dinar. 

FINAL REPORT: ON 2 JUN 04, THIS INVESTIGATION WAS INITIATED BASED ON A MEMORANDUM OF TRANSMITTAL 01 71-04- CID919 FROM THE 75TH MILITARY POLICE DETACHMENT (CID) (FWD), LSA ANACONDA, BALAD, IZ, WHICH RELATED WAS MISTREATED AND THREATENED WHILE DETAINED AT AN UNKNOWN FACILITY IN BALAD, IZ AND HAD 30,300,000.00 LRAQI DINAR SEIZED FROM HIM, OF WHICH ONLY 8 MILLION WAS RETURNED TO HIM UPON HIS RELEASE. INVESTIGATION ESTABLISHED THERE WAS INSUFFICIENT EVIDENCE TO SUBSTANTIATE I CLAIM OF CRUELTY AND MALTREATMENT AND AGGRAVATED ASSAULT. THEREFORE, THE ALLEGATIONS WERE UNFOUNDED. WAS STOPPED AT A SECURITY CHECKPOINT FOR TRANSPORTING AN EXCESS OF 25 MILLION LRAQI DINAR. HE WAS THEN TRANSPORTED TO A TEMPORARY DETENTION FACILITY IN BALAD,



IZ. MONEY WAS TRANSPORTED BY SUBSEQUENTLY TURNED THE MONEY OVER TO THE 118TH INFANTRY

BATTALION'S S2 OFFICE FOR SAFEKEEPING. AFTER RECOUNTING THE MONEY, IT WAS DETERMINED THERE WAS ONLY 8 MILLION IRAQI DINAR, WHICH INDICATED THERE WAS NO REASON TO HOLD HOWEVER, REFUSED TO LEAVE WITHOUT ALL OF HIS MONEY, MAINTAINING HE HAD 30,300,000.00 IRAQI DINAR, AND HE STAYED OF HIS OWN FREE WILL. RELATED THE MONEY HAD BEEN ACQUIRED THROUGH THE SALE OF THE VILLAGE LIVESTOCK AND HE COULD NOT RETURN TO HIS VILLAGE WITHOUT THE MONEY. FILED A CLAIM AND WAS FORCED TO LEAVE A FEW DAYS LATER WITH ONLY 8 MILLION LRAQI DINAR.

INVESTIGATION ESTABLISHED THERE WAS SUPPICIENT EVIDENCE TO BELIEVE AND WERE DERELICT IN THEIR DUTIES FOR NOT MAINTAINING THE PROPER ACCOUNTABILITY OF THE 30.3 MILLION IRAQI DINAR. IT WAS DETERMINED THROUGH THE CONDUCT OF THIS INVESTIGATION AND ALL HAD CONTACT WITH THE MONEY BUT NEVER PROPERLY DOCUMENTED THE TRANSFER OF THE MONEY, NOR DID THEY MAINTAIN ANY TYPE OF CHAIN OF CUSTODY.

INVESTIGATION FURTHER ESTABLISHED THERE WAS SUFFICIENT EVIDENCE TO SUBSTANTIATE THE OFFENSE OF LARCENY OCCURRED BUT A THOROUGH INVESTIGATION DID NOT IDENTIFY A SUBJECT.

An Iraqi individual was detained at the nearby Iraqi Civil Defense Corps check-point with approximately \$30 million Iraqi dinar. This was over the 25 million dinar limit where individuals had to explain the source of their money. The Iraqi was brought to my Company Headquarters on Highway One (currently the local ICDC headquarters), as per SOP, at about 1900 hours. He attempted to justify the money by showing us a two-month old reciept for \$16 million dinar written in Arabic thinking we could not read it. When the individual was confronted by the age and amount of the receipt he refused to talk to us further. He was detained at my headquarters overnight with the money, and both were sent to Battalion Headquarters the following day with the 1SG's daily logistics patrol and the standard detainee paperwork. (2 sworn statements, and the coalition detainee form) This event was never brought to my attention for the remainder of my tour in Iraq. Upon return to the U.S. on 18 March 2004, (three months later), I was told that there was an investigation regarding larceny and detainee abuse. I have no knowledge of there being any issue with the above events until the week of 7 June when I was called by CID.

This is regarding events that took place well over a year ago, and were fairly commonplace in nature, thus this is a statement of my best recollection of the facts. Individual was detained by the Iraqi ICDC at a highway checkpoint and transferred to the custody of my Company HQ in the early evening. I do not remember, the exact amount of his receipt, but it did not match the amount in question. I think there was a translator who read the receipt for us, but my Arabic numbers were good enough, I could have determined his story didn't wash. I questioned him about the source and use of the money, and he refused to answer my questions. 29 million dinar is an amount that sticks in my head as to the total of the money. The thing that was strange was that it was in very large bills, (10,000 and 1,000 instead of the usual bags of 250s). and I were the ones that counted the money initially to determine the amount. The detainee was taken to the Bn TOC by my 1SG on logpac the following day including a Bradley escort and his HUMMVEE driver around noon the next day. Included was a sworn statement by me as to why he was being detained and the amount of the money he was detained for. This sworn statement was unit SOP for accounting for detained money. There was no procedure for accounting for confiscated money other than stating the amount in the two sworn statements that were transferred with the individual. Transfers in amounts well over a 100 million dinar took place in this manner over a half dozen times during our tour without incident of complaint. That this 29 million dinar would be stolen while 100s of millions was not doesn't really make much sense to me, but it was near then of the tour, so all things are possible. Idid not take any of the money in question and do not know if it was stolen or who did







A. With the sheep man, yes.

Q. Do you know how the money was transported to the Pen during that incident?

A. It was transported in a box. I don't know what type of vehicle. I do know we got it as a box. I filled out the property voucher, but he wouldn't sign it. That is the only way we could get him into the Pen was with the property vouchers. The actual chain of custody would begin at the Pen.

Q. Who all was involved with transporting/transferring the money?

A. It was either the TCP guys, the infantry guys, on their way back to their FOB's would drop off the individuals and property to the Pen, or a 1SG would pick up the LOGPAC's and would pick up detainees, if there were any, to take to the Pen.

Q. What was the procedure for handling seized money?

A. If an individual was picked up as a money trafficker, they would be inprocessed, the individuals get put in the detention facility, the property would go into the S2 shop in a cubby hole, in it's original container. The money bags are about 3 feet tall, similar to a mail bag.

Q. When money was brought in was it always counted?

A. No. Q. Why?

A. Because we was a five man office and we didn't have the manpower to count dinar when we were working combat operations. If it was the big bags of money, it would be "I'm signing over X amount of bags, how deep, how wide and how tall" whether they were sealed bags or not. There was no way we could count that much dinar.

Q. Did <u>von work</u> at any of the checkpoints in Samarra?

A. No.

Q. Where did work?

A. He worked in the detainment facility with me. I don't think the guy ever left the FOB. He wrote the

INTSUM's. That is an Intelligence Summary. He did mostly administrative work.

Q. Were you present when was released from the detainment facility?

A. I don't know who that guy is.

Q. Do you recall money in the amount of 210,000,000.00 dinar being seized?

A. I do not remember that amount of money coming in. I don't know where we would have kept it.

Q. Did you ever hear the second second tell a detainee his money was "burned up?"

A. No. The only time he would have dealings with the detainees. He might have walked them out to the gate. The only time he would have dealings with the detainees would be to take them to the Brigade facility or escort them to the gate when released. An officer had to sign the detainees into the Brigade facility.

Q. When a detainee was released, who released their property back to them?

A. The way it normally happened, was with the money trafficker, the money would be given back to them and then released

Q. Who signed the property form when the detainee was released?

A. No one. In most situations, about 99.9% of the time, they were happy to get their property back and they would leave. We didn't save any of our property vouchers. It's possible the documentation was handed over to the unit that relieved us.

Q. Do you know what unit replaced your unit?

A. No I do not.

Q. Where did 1 work?

A. He was the C Company 1SG in Ishaki, Iraq, which is west of Balad.

Q. Would he have been near Samarra in Nov 03?

A. Yes. Ishaki is about half way between Samarra and Balad.





there might have been one more besides the two we talked about. It very well was a rumor that I heard somebody talking about. I believed it may have involved the police. Also, the Iraqi Police picked up the other guy that claimed he was missing money, then brought him to me at the PEN. O. Did you ever hear to "never come back looking for his money, tell ' and if he ever did come back that he would "bury him in the desert". A. No. That is like the complete opposite of what is. He is very timid and quiet. He hardly had any interaction with the detainees. Q. Would he handle claims from the detainees when they lost property? A. He might have. Because we were such a small shop we would do other jobs. It would have been him, myself or another NCO. O. Is there anybody else that worked in the facility that may have said that same statement to A. The only one that could have said that would have been possibly but I don't know. It would be hard to say for sure. Q. Did you hear make threatening or abrasive statements like that to other detainees or soldiers? A. I think there were a couple of times he made statements to detainees. was a very loud person. Q. Was he aggressive? A. I never saw him be aggressive. He was just loud. He would walk into a room and yell. Q. What kind of statements would he make to the detainees? A. Possibly something like "we'll arrest your whole family if you don't tell us why you have that mortar round in your possession" or "I don't believe you as a fisherman would use a radio controlled IED to fish". Q. Did he ever threaten the detainees? A. I can't think of any specifics. Q. Did you ever hear anything that sounded like threats of bodily harm to the detainees? A. No, I don't recall anything like that. A Q. Do you know first name? O. Can you describe A. 6 foot or taller, Caucasian, blonde hair, might still be active duty. Q.
