Following up on our September 30, 2010 letter, on behalf of the Central Intelligence Agency ("CIA"), we write to enclose documents responsive to the Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA") request that is the subject of the above-referenced litigation and to inform you that an additional nine documents responsive to your request are being withheld in full pursuant to applicable FOIA exemptions.

The enclosed three documents have been determined to be releasable in part, and the remaining nine processed documents are being withheld in full pursuant to some or all of the following exemptions: 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(1), (b)(2), (b)(3), (b)(5) and (b)(6). Additionally, the CIA has referred one document to the Department of State for its review and direct reply to you.
