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DETAILS

BAISIS FOR INVESTIGATION:

About 0530, 24 JUN 03, this office received notification by email that an alleged assault had occurred in the 1/325th Airborne Infantry Regiment area of responsibility.

About 0600Z, 25 JUN 03, SA [REDACTED] b7c-1, b6-1 and SA [REDACTED] b7c-1, b6-1 this office, met with CPT [REDACTED] b7c-3, b6-1 C Company (CO), 1st Battalion (BN) 325th Airborne Infantry Regiment (AIR) and learned that there was a commanders inquiry that produced over 30 statements regarding three separate incidents. CPT [REDACTED] b7c-3, b6-1 related his investigation produced information that two different soldiers on the same patrol team committed two separate alleged assaults on two different Iraqi civilians and a third soldier committed the offense of destruction of private property. CPT [REDACTED] b7c-3, b6-1 provided a copy of the commander's inquiry (Exhibit 2).

About 0805Z, 25 JUN 03, SA [REDACTED] b7c-1, b6-1 and SA [REDACTED] b7c-1, b6-1 interviewed PFC [REDACTED] b7c-4, b6-4 [REDACTED] b7c-4, b6-4 B CO 307th ENG BN, who provided a sworn statement (Exhibit 3). PFC [REDACTED] b7c-4, b6-4 stated on 20 JUN 03 he was on patrol with LT [REDACTED] b7c-4, b6-4 A CO 1/13th Armor and other individuals who he could not remember all of the names of. PFC [REDACTED] b7c-4, b6-4 stated his patrol drove into the ammo factory in sector 45 when they witnessed Iraqi civilians looting from the ammo factory. PFC [REDACTED] b7c-5, b6-5 further stated SGT [REDACTED] b7c-5, b6-5 B CO 307th ENG BN, exited his vehicle and approached an Iraqi vehicle that was loaded with looted metal. SGT [REDACTED] b7c-5, b6-5 entered the Iraqi truck and drove it back and forth in an attempt to dislodge the metal from the vehicle. While driving the Iraqi truck he caused damage to the truck and the radiator began to leak. PFC [REDACTED] b7c-4, b6-4 stated later in the evening the patrol drove by the same truck and stopped. SGT [REDACTED] b7c-5, b6-5 then received direction from LT [REDACTED] b7c-5, b6-5 to cut the tires of the truck and SGT [REDACTED] b7c-5, b6-5 then cut the tires. PFC [REDACTED] b7c-4, b6-4 stated after SGT [REDACTED] b7c-4, b6-4 cut the tires of the vehicle his patrol began to drive around again. PFC [REDACTED] b7c-4, b6-4 stated sometime in the evening his patrol detained an Iraqi for looting. PFC [REDACTED] b7c-4, b6-4 stated his patrol drove around for over an hour with the Iraqi when LT [REDACTED] b7c-5, b6-5 pulled the patrol over into a field. PFC [REDACTED] b7c-5, b6-5 further stated while in the field LT [REDACTED] b7c-5, b6-5 downloaded the prisoner and removed his flexi cuffs and the sandbag that was on his head. PFC [REDACTED] b7c-5, b6-5 stated LT [REDACTED] b7c-5, b6-5 escorted the detainee to the front of the lead truck and sat him down. At that point LT [REDACTED] b7c-5, b6-5 said something to the detainee and then put his 9mm pistol to the head of the detainee. PFC [REDACTED] b7c-5, b6-5 stated LT [REDACTED] b7c-5, b6-5 then pointed the 9mm away from the detainee and fired a shot. After LT [REDACTED] b7c-5, b6-5 fired the shot he got back into his vehicle and took a picture of the detainee sitting on the ground. PFC [REDACTED] b7c-4, b6-5 stated about 1330, 22 JUN 03, he was on patrol again with LT [REDACTED] b7c-5, b6-5 when he witnessed SGT [REDACTED] b7c-5, b6-5 have a Iraqi boy squatting down behind a building. PFC [REDACTED] b7c-5, b6-5 stated he saw SGT [REDACTED] b7c-5, b6-5 point his rifle away from the boy and pull the trigger but no round went off and PFC [REDACTED] b7c-4, b6-5 heard a metallic click. PFC [REDACTED] b7c-5, b6-5 stated he witnessed SGT [REDACTED] b7c-5, b6-5 pull back the charging handle

on his rifle and again point the weapon away from the Iraqi boy and pull the trigger firing of one shot, then SGT [REDACTED] let the boy go back to where his father and brother were sitting. PFC [REDACTED] stated at that point SGT [REDACTED] let the man and his two sons leave. b7c-5, b6-5

About 0830Z, 25 JUN 03, SA [REDACTED] advised SGT [REDACTED] of his legal rights which he waived and provided a sworn statement (Exhibit 4). SGT [REDACTED] stated he was unable to see what was going on in front of the lead vehicle while he was on patrol with LT [REDACTED] on 20 JUN 03. SGT [REDACTED] stated he did here a gunshot and did question LT [REDACTED] what had happened and LT [REDACTED] told him that he was being attacked by a dog. SGT [REDACTED] further stated he was present on 22 JUN 03 when SGT [REDACTED] escorted one of the three detainees around the side of a building and fired a shot. SGT [REDACTED] stated he had received orders from LT [REDACTED] via radio to detain the Iraqi men they had found looting in the ammo factory. SGT [REDACTED] stated he instructed SGT [REDACTED] to take the detainee's to the truck and flexi cuff them. SGT [REDACTED] stated SGT [REDACTED] escorted one of the Iraqi boys behind the rear of the vehicle. SGT [REDACTED] stated a few moments after SGT [REDACTED] went around the back of the truck SGT [REDACTED] heard a gunshot. SGT [REDACTED] further stated he observed SGT [REDACTED] walking around the building with the Iraqi boy, at which time SGT [REDACTED] related to SGT [REDACTED] that the Iraqi boy tried to run. SGT [REDACTED] stated at that time the three Iraqi's were released.

About 1000Z, 25 JUN 03, SA [REDACTED] and SA [REDACTED] advised SGT [REDACTED] of his legal rights which he waived and provided a sworn statement (Exhibit 5), wherein he stated he had no knowledge of the incident on 20 JUN 03 with LT [REDACTED] but he did not believe the story about the dog wanting to bite LT [REDACTED] because there were no dogs in the area and the situation seemed odd. SGT [REDACTED] stated he did witness SGT [REDACTED] driving in the Iraqi's truck and then later cutting the tires of that truck. SGT [REDACTED] further stated about 1300, 22 JUN 03, he was on patrol with LT [REDACTED] when the patrol entered the ammo factory and witnessed an Iraqi man and his two sons looting. SGT [REDACTED] stated upon detaining the Iraqi's he asked them if why they were looting and if the man wanted his two sons to get hurt or shot or go to jail. SGT [REDACTED] further stated SGT [REDACTED] then came over and took control of the detainees. SGT [REDACTED] stated he went over to LT [REDACTED] who told SGT [REDACTED] to "scare the shit out of them" and after they were crying SGT [REDACTED] could let them go. SGT [REDACTED] further stated at that point he went over and grabbed one of the boys and led him around the corner of a building. SGT [REDACTED] stated he pointed his weapon away from the boy and pulled the trigger, but there was no round in the chamber so he pulled the charging handle on his rifle back and loaded the weapon. SGT [REDACTED] stated he then pointed the weapon away from the Iraqi and pulled the trigger shooting off one round. SGT [REDACTED] further stated after shooting off one round he brought the sun back to the father and let the detainees go. SGT [REDACTED] further

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^{b7c-5, b6-5} stated LT [redacted] condoned scare tactics to deter further offenses by individuals trying to loot. SGT [redacted] stated LT [redacted] never corrected any previous incidents where warning shots ^{b7c-5, b6-5} were fired and seemed to express that warning shots were authorized.

About 1133Z, 25 JUN 03, SA ^{b7c-1, b6-1} [redacted] advised LT ^{b7c-5, b6-5} [redacted] of his legal rights (Exhibit 6), which he invoked and requested to speak with a lawyer.

About 0620Z, 30 JUN 03, SA ^{b7c-1, b6-1} [redacted] interviewed PFC ^{b7c-4, b6-4} [redacted], B CO 307 ENG BN, 82nd AIR who provided a sworn statement (Exhibit 7). PFC [redacted] stated on 20 ^{b7c-4, b6-4} JUN 03 he was on patrol with LT [redacted] when they picked up an Iraqi male, between 14 and 17 ^{b7c-5, b6-5} years of age. PFC [redacted] stated at some point in the night, just before they got off of patrol, the ^{b7c-4, b6-4} patrol all of a sudden stopped. PFC [redacted] stated he dismounted his vehicle and was providing ^{b7c-4, b6-4} security when he heard a pop. PFC [redacted] stated the lights on the truck were off so he turned on ^{b7c-4, b6-4} his NVG's and looked toward the noise, approximately 5-10 seconds after the shot. PFC [redacted] ^{b7c-4, b6-4} further stated when he looked toward the noise when he had his NVG's on he could see LT [redacted] ^{b7c-5, b6-5} re-holstering his weapon and staring at the Iraqi detainee about they had picked up earlier ^{b7c-5, b6-5} in the evening about 10 feet in front of the truck, who was laying on the ground covering his head with his arms and hand and seemed to be crying. PFC [redacted] further stated he did not witness any ^{b7c-4, b6-4} dogs in the area or see anybody standing next to LT [redacted] when he heard the shot. Further ^{b7c-5, b6-5} PFC [redacted] stated he had no knowledge of the incident on the 22nd of June that SGT [redacted] ^{b7c-4, 5 b6-4, 5} was involved with.

^{b7c-5, b6-5} AGENT'S COMMENT: The fact that 1LT [redacted] had his focus directed at the detainee, and not in any other direction, infers that there was nothing else in the area of concern (an aggressive dog).

About 0630Z, 30 JUN 03, SA ^{b7c-1, b6-1} [redacted] interviewed SPC ^{b7c-4, b6-4} [redacted], B CO 307th ENG BN, 82nd AIR who provided a sworn statement (Exhibit 8). SPC ^{b7c-4, b6-4} [redacted] stated on the night of the 20th of June he was on patrol when his unit picked up a ^{b7c-4, b6-4} young boy who had been looting. SPC [redacted] stated his patrol continued on with the patrol ^{b7c-4, b6-4} and eventually turned down a back road they had never gone down before, and SPC [redacted] had no idea why they were where they were. Further SPC [redacted] stated ^{b7c-4, b6-4} the tankers were in the lead vehicle and the engineers were in the rear vehicle when they had stopped. SPC [redacted] stated "Blue 1", LT [redacted] exited his vehicle and came around to ^{b7c-4, 5 b6-4} the follow truck and had the detainee removed from the truck. SPC [redacted] further stated ^{b7c-4, b6-4} he watched LT [redacted] guide the detainee around to the front of the lead vehicle, at which time ^{b7c-5, b6-5} SPC [redacted] dismounted his vehicle and started to pull security, then SPC [redacted] ^{b7c-4, b6-4} heard a shot fired shortly after the LT and detainee were in front of the vehicle. SPC [redacted] ^{b7c-4, b6-4} ducked because he thought they were being shot at. At that time SPC [redacted] stated he ^{b7c-4, b6-4}

asked toward LT [REDACTED] and could see LT [REDACTED] looking at the detainee and not in any other direction, also LT [REDACTED] was removing the flexi cuffs from the detainee. SPC [REDACTED] further stated the lights on the lead truck were on and he could see LT [REDACTED] just outside of the beams of light and there were no dogs present. SPC [REDACTED] corroborated that the LT and detainee were approximately 10 feet in front of the lead vehicle. SPC [REDACTED] further stated he witnessed LT [REDACTED] taking a picture of the detainee while the detainee was on the ground lying. SPC [REDACTED] stated he was not present when the incident with SGT [REDACTED] occurred and that he had heard SGT [REDACTED] talking about the incident but walked away because he did not want to hear the story. SPC [REDACTED] further related details of an incident that he said occurred on the 21st of June where he and SGT [REDACTED] attempted to dislodge a metal from a truck owned by Iraqi's that were looting at the ammo factory. SPC [REDACTED] stated on 22 Jun 03 he was present when his patrol stopped in an ammo factory and detained three Iraqi's for looting. SPC [REDACTED] further stated he witnessed SGT [REDACTED] walk one of the 13-year-old boys around the corner of a building. SPC [REDACTED] stated he wanted nothing to do with what SGT [REDACTED] was doing so he walked back to the cab of the truck. SPC [REDACTED] further stated a few minutes later he heard a gunshot and about five minutes later SGT [REDACTED] and the boy walked back around the corner of the building.

about 0634, 30 JUN 03, SA [REDACTED] interviewed SPC [REDACTED] B CO, 307th ENG, 82nd AIR who provided a sworn statement (Exhibit 9). SPC [REDACTED] stated on 20 JUN 03 he was on patrol with LT [REDACTED] when they detained a boy for looting. SPC [REDACTED] stated his patrol continued it's patrol and toward the end of the patrol the patrol went down a road that they had never been on and continued down the road until it ended. SPC [REDACTED] stated once the vehicles were stopped LT [REDACTED] who SPC [REDACTED] can only identify by sight and by the name "Blue 1", approached the vehicle and ordered the detainee be downloaded from the vehicle and given to him. SPC [REDACTED] further stated he was standing in front of the truck and witnessed LT [REDACTED] make the detainee get on his knees, at which point SPC [REDACTED] witnessed LT [REDACTED] bend down and say something to the detainee. SPC [REDACTED] further stated he witnessed LT [REDACTED] stand back up and raise his weapon to the back of the detainees head, the LT [REDACTED] raised the barrel of the weapon just above the head of the detainee and shoot off a round. SPC [REDACTED] stated LT [REDACTED] released the prisoner and got back into his truck and they drove off leaving the detainee behind.

PFC [REDACTED] stated while on patrol with LT [REDACTED] on 20 JUN 03 his patrol picked up an Iraqi boy for looting. stated he was in the trail vehicle and stopped his vehicle about 100 meters short of the lead vehicle. PFC [redacted] further stated he and his team dismounted his truck and began pulling security and some of the tankers came back to the truck and removed the detainee from the back. PFC [redacted] stated the tankers moved the detainee up to the front of the lead vehicle, and soon after PFC [redacted] heard a shot. PFC [redacted] further stated he responded to the gunshot by asking his squad leader, SGT [redacted], what had happened. PFC [redacted] stated SGT [redacted] ran to the front of the lead vehicle and then shortly after returned. PFC [redacted] stated while SGT [redacted] and SGT [redacted] were detaining the Iraqi's PFC [redacted] was pulling security around his truck. PFC [redacted] stated he went out to the road to show the tankers where his truck was parked because LT [redacted] was with them and wanted PFC [redacted] patrol to hold the Iraqi's for his arrival. PFC [redacted] further stated while back at his vehicle waiting for the arrival of LT [redacted] PFC [redacted] approached him and [redacted] and told them how SGT [redacted] wanted to take one of the Iraqi's behind a building and pretend to execute one of the boys as a way to make a point to the father. PFC [redacted] further stated when SGT [redacted] passed by with the boy PFC [redacted] yelled for him but SGT [redacted] either did not hear him or ignored him because SGT [redacted] proceeded to take the boy behind the building. PFC [redacted] stated he heard a single shot and then observed SGT [redacted] come back around the building with the boy following. PFC [redacted] stated his patrol the mounted their vehicles and drove off leaving the Iraqi's behind.

At 0745, 30 JUN 03, SA [redacted] coordinated with CPT [redacted] Commander, A Co, 1/325th Inf Bn, 82nd Abn Div, Ft Bragg, NC at which time the facts pertaining this investigation were discussed. SA [redacted] detailed probable cause to believe that LT [redacted] may have been in possession of the disposable camera, at which time CPT [redacted] gave Commander's Authorization to conduct a search of LT [redacted] personal belongings, living area, and vehicle.

At 1200, 30 Jun 03, SA [redacted] accompanied by 1LT [redacted] XO, A Co, 1/325th Inf Bn, 82nd Abn Div, Ft Bragg, NC, met with 1LT [redacted] at his assigned living area. SA [redacted] inquired to 1LT [redacted] if he recalled his rights advisement, to which he replied he recalled and understood what his rights were. SA [redacted] advised of the Commander's Authorization to search, and requested 1LT provide the camera in question. 1LT made a spontaneous utterance that he had "two maybe three cameras" which had been sent to him in care packages. 1LT [redacted] inquired as to "why they were important" concerning the investigation and stated that he would willing provide them to USACIDC. 1LT [redacted] went through all of his

belongings, in which he failed to locate any disposable cameras. SA [redacted] ^{b7c-1, b6-1} located one camera, still in it's factory unbroken wrapper. A second "two pack" disposable camera set was located, in which contained one camera, with the other missing. The remaining camera was still in it's factory wrapper. SA [redacted] posed, "The big question is where's the other camera"? 1LT [redacted] ^{b7c-1, b6-1} in a smug reply stated, "I couldn't even begin to tell you"? SA [redacted] finished the ^{b7c-5, b6-5, 1} search of 1LT [redacted] personal gear, barracks room, and tank, bumper #33, which failed to ^{b7c-5, b6-5} locate the camera in question.

AGENT'S COMMENT: It was noted that 1LT [redacted] ^{b7c-5, b6-5} lived very neatly organized and appeared doubtful that he would not account of the camera's location. 1LT [redacted] never eluded to the fact ^{b7c-5, b6-5} that he had lost the camera.

About 0800Z, 30 JUN 03, SA [redacted] ^{b7c-1, b6-1} captured 6 digital pictures (Exhibit 11) of the crime scene using a Kodak EasyShare LS443 digital camera.

About 1200, 30 JUN 03, SA [redacted] ^{b7c-1, b6-1} and SA [redacted] ^{b7c-1, b6-1} coordinated with the 1st AD SJA who opined there was probable cause to believe LT [redacted] did commit the offenses of willful ^{b7c-5, b6-5} dereliction of duty, assault, conduct unbecoming, reckless endangerment, obstruction of justice and maltreatment.

AGENT'S COMMENT: Both SA [redacted] ^{b7c-1, b6-1} and SA [redacted] ^{b7c-1, b6-1} have witnessed ferral or stray dogs since being deployed to Iraq on numerous occasions. These dogs appear to be more afraid of humans than humans of them. These dogs run at the first sight of humans and the account of "an aggressive dog" coming out of the darkness, near two five ton trucks with lights on and engines running appears to be highly unlikely. In conjunction with the fact that the shot occurred moments after the detainee was brought to the front of the truck, appears to be more than pure coincidence. The statement by 1LT [redacted] in regards to firing the shot at the dog, to "protect himself and the ^{b7c-5, b6-5} detainee" further contradicts the fact that the LT left the teenager in the area with possible dangerous animals.

He had run over cylinder blocks, concertina wire, side of berm. Then after he had stopped the vehicle in front of us, I could see the radiator leaking and fuel leaking from underneath. SGT. [REDACTED] *b7C-5, b6-5* was going to drive it again but two M.P. vehicles had pulled into the compound. We left immediately. We were still on patrol around our sector, and saw the same vehicle parked on the road in front of the ammo factory when SGT. [REDACTED] *b7C-5, b6-5* jumped out of the truck and slashed all four tires. Then we saw the same vehicle further up the road and saw the owner of the vehicle pouring water into his radiator. 2LT [REDACTED] *b7C-5, b6-5* jumped out of the truck and said to the Iraqis, "If I catch you stealing again Ali Baaba, pow, pow". Then he got back into his truck we left, [REDACTED] *b7C-4, b6-4*

On the night of June 20, 03 we had caught an Iraqi boy and we had him detained for maybe an hour and a half while we drove around patrolling our sector. At the end of our patrol, we drove out to a field and 2LT [REDACTED] *b7C-5, b6-5* had the boy off to the side of the truck into the light of the headlights. 2LT [REDACTED] *b7C-5, b6-5* then fired off a shot from his nine mm on the side of the boy's head. On the evening of the 20th of June LT *[REDACTED]* b7c-5, b6-5 supposedly fired a shot in a mock execution style. I did not witness this and was told that he fired upon a dog. I personally don't believe this happened but have no way of being sure. On 22 June we detained one man and his two sons for looting. Upon guarding them I asked the man a series of questions to try to impress upon him and his sons that looting was not acceptable such as telling them they could go to jail, they could have gotten hurt, asked the man if he wanted to loose either of his sons and asked him while pointing to each of his two sons, he said that he would rather be the one and I then asked why they were looting. SGT *[REDACTED]* b7c-4, b6-4 then came over and I left I briefly met with LT *[REDACTED]* b7c-5, b6-5 and he said to scare the shot out of them and after they were all crying let them go that is when I grabbed one of the kids took them around the building set him down and discharged around in the opposite direction of the detainee after that I brought the kid back and we let the detainees go. The LT condoned the use of scare tactics to prevent persons from continuing to loot and condoned the above scenario.
