





LATER LT DIRECTED HIS PATROL OFF THE ROAD AND INTO A DESOLATE FIELD. ONCE IN THE FIELD LT DIRECTED THE 676-5,66-5 DETAINEE REMOVED FROM THE BACK OF THE TRUCK AND THEN LED THE DETAINEE IN FRONT OF THE LEAD VEHICLE. LT HAD THE 676-5,66-5 FLEXI CUFFS REMOVED FROM THE DETAINEE'S WRIST AND THE SANDBAG REMOVED FROM THE DETAINEE'S HEAD. LT THEN 676-5,66-5 MADE THE IRAQI SIT ON THE GROUND AND THEN PUT HIS 9MM PISTOL TO THE HEAD OF THE IRAQI. LT MADE AN UNKNOWN 646-5,66-5 UTTERANCE AND THEN POINTED THE PISTOL OFF TO THE SIDE OF THE IRAQI AND FIRED A SHOT. LT THEN RELEASED THE 676-5 DETAINEE.

AT 1133Z, 25 JUN 03 LT WAS ADVISED OF HIS LEGAL RIGHTS, WHICH HE INVOKED. WITNESS STATEMENTS WERE OBTAINED FROM U.S. SOLDIERS WHO WITNESSES THE INCIDENT.
