Response to a request from Federal Bureau of Investigation Headquarters (FBIHQ) to provide behavioral support to the detainee interview process at the United States Naval Base, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba (GTMO), an assessment team from the Behavioral Analysis Unit (BAU), National Center for the Analysis of Violent Crime (NCAVC), Critical Incidence Response Group (CIRG), traveled to GTMO and conducted an on-site review. This report summarizes the findings of that team.

The findings and recommendations contained herein are based solely upon personal observations, information, and documentation obtained by the BAU during the on-site review.






