

On 08May06, a preliminary investigation was conducted in the Hamdania area surrounding the death of V/AWAD that included review of scene photographs taken immediately following the shooting, Command records pertaining to the incident, and a visit to the death scene in the company of Command members, including identified the location of V/AWAD's body and that of the squad at the time of the shooting. The relinquished spent ammunition identified as having been recovered from the scene, along with one live 7.62mm round. During subsequent questioning regarding their roles in the incident, **37. 49.33 37**, 4 and confessed their squad had abducted and murdered WAWAD, then staged the death scene in order to cover up the crime. Several images of USMC personnel, equipment, and their living quarters were observed. Results of examination of both items determined the Memorex thumbdrive had been operated in the Dell Notebook computer on multiple occasions and data was mutually exchanged. In addition, one file named "IED shooting 26th.doc" was located on both items. 
