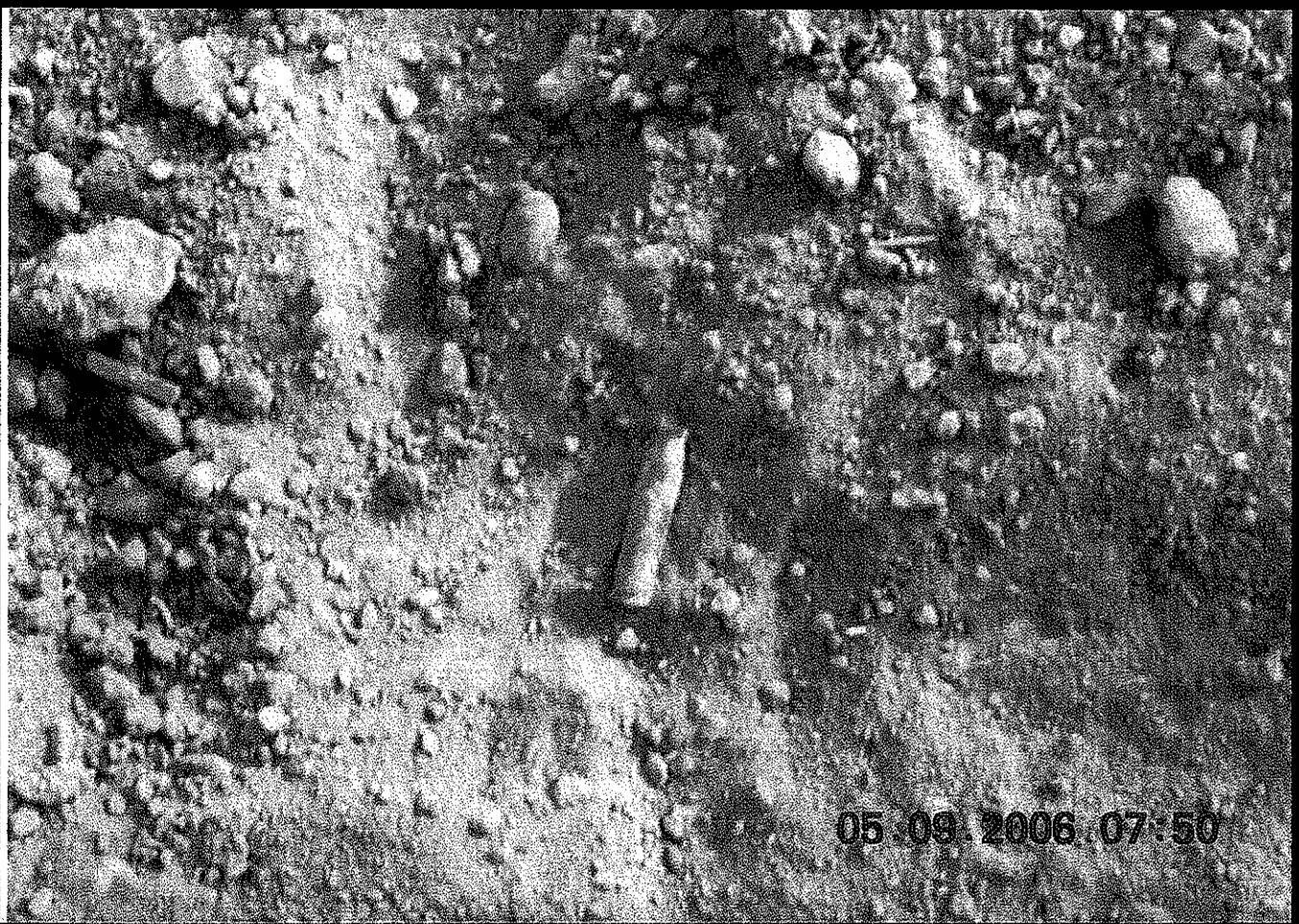

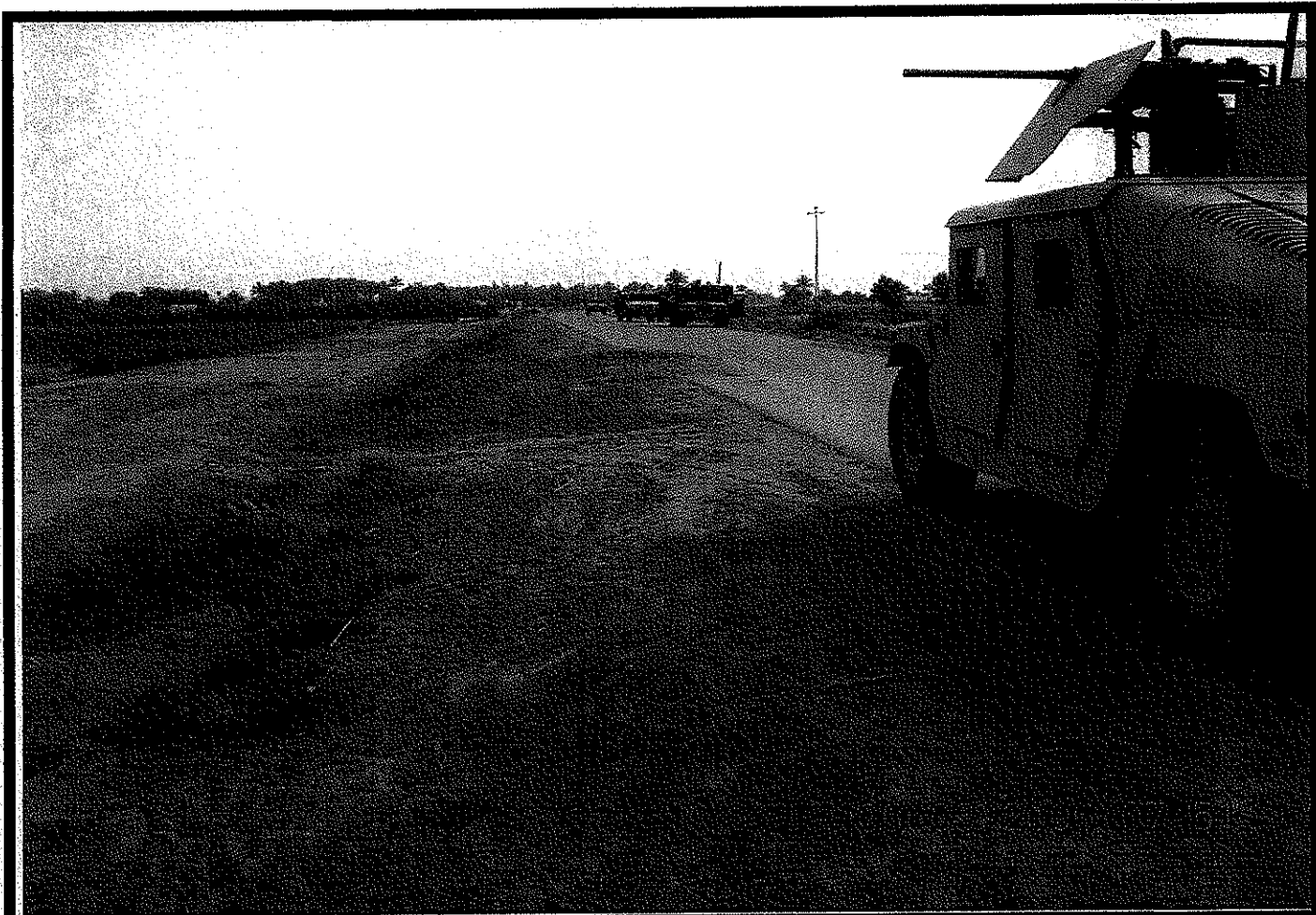

RECEIPT OF AMMO COUNT PROVIDED BY COMMAND/16MAY06

1. On 16MAY06, [REDACTED] Kilo Company Third Battalion, Fifth Marine (K/3/5) Hamdania, Iraq provided Reporting Agent with the ammunition count that was reported in by 1st Squad, 2nd Platoon K/3/5, the night V/AWAD was killed. According to Command records 160 rounds were expended that night. Records indicate that one hundred rounds of 4&1 linked 5.56 (alternating four rounds full metal jacketed and one tracer) fifty rounds loose, 5.56 and fifty rounds of 5.56 and ten rounds of 5.56 tracer rounds were expended.
